

Section 13 - Disposal Considerations

Disposal: Treatment, storage, transportation and disposal must be in accordance with applicable Federal, State/Provincial, and Local regulations. Remove non-usable solid material and/or contaminated soil, for disposal in an approved and permitted landfill.

Container Cleaning and Disposal: Completely empty bag by shaking and tapping sides and bottom to loosen clinging particles. Empty residue into application equipment. Then, dispose of bags in a sanitary landfill or by incineration, or if allowed by state and local authorities, by burning. If burned, stay out of smoke.
